

<sup>1</sup> The General Fund receives demand and term deposits from depositors and pays out interest on these deposits. The rate indicated is the average rate paid out during the year.

<sup>2</sup> Income earned on the investments of the Caisse's General Fund and Individual Funds is paid out or allocated to participation deposit holders. The rate indicated is the average annual rate. The rate represents only the income accounted for during the year on depositors' investments. It does not account for the change in the market value of investments. For purposes of this calculation, participation deposits are computed at book value. The rate is different from the time-weighted rate of return which includes both income and changes in the market value of investments.

The figures for 1991 have been restated to conform with the presentation of 1992.
