BACKGROUND

Mr. Beroutsos has extensive experience in international private equity. In particular, he established and led the Global Private Equity practice at McKinsey & Company, where he served as Director/Senior Partner. After 17 years with the Firm, he became Partner and Senior Managing Director at Eton Park Capital Management, where he led the Private Investments group.

He later founded and served as Managing Partner of One Point Capital, a private equity investment firm in New York.

Andreas Beroutsos holds a Bachelor's degree in Social Sciences from Harvard University and an MBA from Harvard Business School.

CONNECTIONS

Mr. Beroutsos served as an independent Board Member of the General Council of the Hellenic Financial Stability Fund (HFSF) in 2013, responsible for managing as principal the four systemic Greek banks, on behalf of the "Troika" (European Commission, European Central Bank and International Monetary Fund) and the Greek government. He participated on several of the World Economic Forum's standing committees and special initiatives from 2002 to 2010, while he also served as a pro bono adviser to the City of New York and Harvard University, while at McKinsey. Mr. Beroutsos served as President of the Harvard Club of New York City from 2011 to 2015. He currently serves or has served on the boards of trustees of various other organizations, including the Sculpture Center (Long Island City, NY), the Lincoln Center Theater (New York), the Archdiocesan Cathedral of the Holy Trinity (New York), Athens College (Greece) and the American Associates of St. Catherine's Foundation for art preservation.
